

Ewelme Winfields

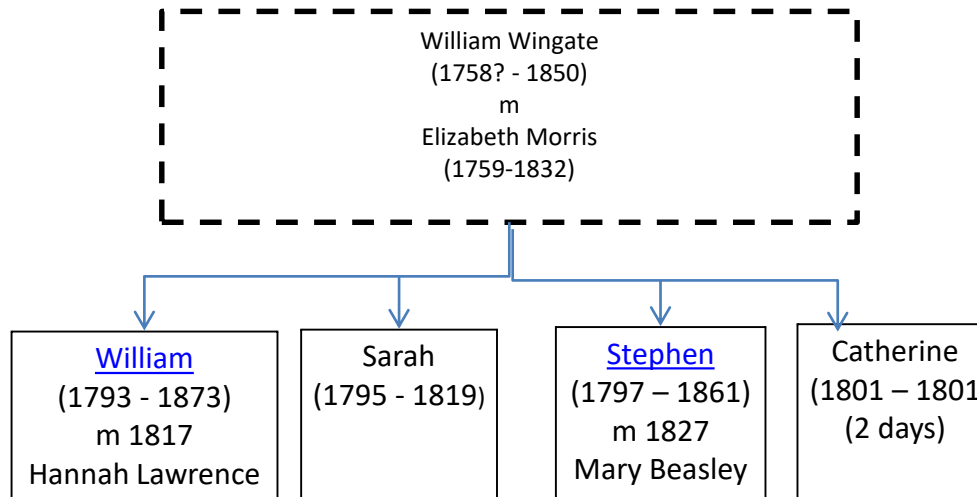
There are over 250 Winfields (including Wingates and Wingfields) who appear in the transcript of the church records (obtained on CD from the Oxfordshire Family History Society) between 1599 and 1979 and as part of tracing my own family history and out of curiosity of establishing how many of the inhabitants of Ewelme whilst I grew up there were related to me, I first needed to organise them into their family groups. There were a lot of them and many had the same name so it is easy to make false assumptions. It is thought that the earliest Winfields listed here were Catholics who attended Britwell Prior. I have not yet found the common link but it seems highly likely that John (born 1782), James (1786), Thomas (1787), William (1793) and Stephen (1797), were either brothers or cousins.

I have used individual pages for each family and creating links to the generations either side. This includes all children baptised or born in the village and any children from these same families who do not appear in the church records but are listed in censuses. I have used Ancestry.com to include censuses and other records, not in an attempt to tell all the stories, but rather to evidence, as far as possible, the additional names and dates included in the family groups for reference. Births and marriages not found in the transcript of the records can be found in dashed rather than solid boxes and references to marriages (or banns) not listed in the church records are noted in italics.

Please note that I have done my best to double-check my entries here but I have worked from the transcript and not the actual church records so any errors in the transcript will be duplicated here! Cross checking with the actual records is the next task!

Please use the accompanying spreadsheet or the Find feature in this file to look for your closest Winfield relative (I have only included those born with Winfield as their surname) and the links should help you to trace their ancestors.
